HISTORY

In studying some of the significant British monarchs of the past, we will be exploring how perceptions of power have changed throughout History and the ways in which we assess the impact of these rulers on Britain and the wider world.

Science

Year 5 will be studying forces, their uses and the ways in which we can investigate the effects of gravity and upthrust.

Year 6 will be examining how we maintain healthy bodies through an in-depth study of the circulatory system.

RE

Our students will be learning about the religion of Islam and the traditions and beliefs that permeate Muslim daily life. We will also be finding out more about how the sense of community is built within the religion in our local area.

ΡE

Children will be introduced to the game of Volleyball and will learn how to set up a series of moves to score, as well as exploring the sport of Tennis. Development of a range of shot types and an understanding of serving will make this an exciting first half term!





ART AND COMPUTING

We will be looking at the work of a number of artists in order to turn 2D shapes into 3D sculptures, inspired by wildlife around us. In Computing, students will be using a range of apps to develop their programming skills.
