GEOGRAPHY

Using our local area, the children will be identifying and comparing human and physical geographical features. Using subject-specific vocabulary, we will be explaining the similarities and differences that we notice.

Science

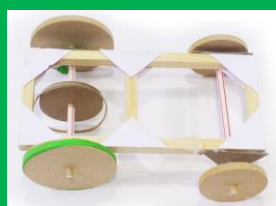
This half term will build upon the learning from our previous sessions, and will focus on the different movements needed to manipulate materials, such as twist, bend and stretch. We will discuss why these allow materials to be used for a variety of jobs.

RE

As well as following the story of the Nativity and Jesus' birth, the children will be finding out about how the theme of 'light' plays a vital role within the season. We will also be making and finding out more about Christingles.

PE

Using different topics as our inspiration, we will be learning, developing and performing a range of new skills in Gymnastics, focusing on balance and accuracy. We will also be honing our sending and receiving skills linked to ball and net games.



DT AND COMPUTING

After exploring toy vehicles, children will learn about how wheels and axles are used to design and make their own moving vehicle. In Computing, we will be exploring different programs to allow us to create digital images and paintings.



PSHE AND RSE

Year 1 will be learning about the importance of collaboration and how it is important to recognise our individuality. Year 2 will be identifying special people in our lives, as well as thinking about how we change as we grow.
