Greece vs the UK

WHAT COMPARISONS CAN WE MAKE IN TERMS OF CLIMATE, WEATHER AND PHYSICAL FEATURES?





GEOGRAPHY

As well as developing our knowledge of European countries and their capital cities, children will be completing an in-depth study of Greece, before making comparisons with the UK based on climate, weather and key landmarks.

Science

Our children will be finding out about how different sounds are made, how sound travels and the ways in which pitch and volume can be altered. There will be lots of practical, hands-on activities for our students to take part in.

RE

As well as following the story of the Nativity and Jesus' birth, the children will be finding out about how the theme of 'light' plays a vital role within the season. We will also be reflecting on some of the stories from the Bible to discover why Jesus is considered the 'Light of the World'.

PE

As always, one class will be attending swimming sessions each week as part of our PE curriculum.

In their Gymnastic sessions, students will be working independently and in groups to perform a series of balances and transitions between shapes to create a sequence.





DT AND COMPUTING

Children will investigate and evaluate a range of different cereal bars and will learn food preparation techniques before going on to design and make their own cereal bar. In Computing, we will be exploring animation software to start to develop our own animations.





PSHE AND RSE

Year 3 will be expanding their understanding of teamwork, as well as identifying their own strengths and weaknesses. Year 4 will be thinking about what makes a good friend and the differences between the male and female
