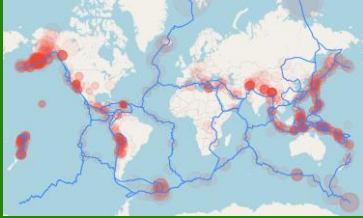


# Earthquakes and their Impact

HOW, WHY AND WHERE DO EARTHQUAKES OCCUR AND WHAT IS THEIR IMPACT?



## GEOGRAPHY

During this topic, students will be identifying the locations of earthquakes across the world, as well as using their knowledge of tectonic plates to describe how one might occur. We will also be exploring their long- and short-term consequences.

## Science

Year 5 will be finding out about how we change as we grow older, thinking about the life cycle as a whole.

Year 6 will be using a range of components to draw, create and test a series of electrical circuits within different contexts.

## RE

As well as following the story of the Nativity, the children will be studying the Gospels from the New Testament to compare and contrast the different versions of the story of Jesus' birth. We will be looking for evidence of themes such as light, peace and hope in these and in our traditions.

## PE

In Gymnastics, we will be perfecting their balances, as well as their forward and backwards rolls. They will be using tension and control to use the apparatus safely. In Basketball, we will learn skills such as shooting, dribbling and defending.



## DT AND COMPUTING

We will be identifying seasonal foods and the ways in which these can be prepared to make balanced meals. In Computing, we will be looking at vector drawing, using lines, curves and singular points to create clear and detailed images.



## PSHE AND RSE

Year 5 will learn about what successful communication looks like and how we can deal with strong emotions. Year 6 will be learning about healthy vs unhealthy relationships and the importance of body positivity.
