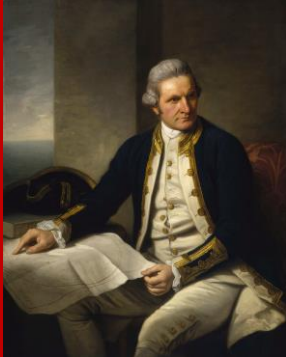


# James Cook

WHO WAS THIS FAMOUS EXPLORER AND WHAT DID HE DISCOVER?



## HISTORY

This half term, we will be finding out about Captain James Cook as another significant local figure. We will be mapping out his journeys around the world and discussing the importance of the locations he travelled to.

## Science

Linked to our learning about James Cook, we will be finding out about polar regions and describing the conditions. We will be thinking about how we could survive in these locations and what we would need with us.

## RE

We will be finding out about how a sense of belonging and community is built into and developed by Christian traditions and celebrations. We will try and find examples of this within daily tasks within a Christian household.

## PE

Children will explore travelling actions, movement skills and balancing. They will understand why it is important to count to music and use this in their dances. In Target games, children will develop their aim using both underarm and overarm actions.



## ART AND COMPUTING

Children will explore how painters sometimes use paint in an expressive and gestural way and learn about primary colours and colour mixing to create abstract still life artwork. In Computing, we will be programming a moving robot to follow a chosen path.



## PSHE

Year 1 will be thinking about their goals and targets in life and the ways in which we can push ourselves to always have high aspirations. Year 2 will explore how we can deal with strong emotions in order to make good choices.
