HISTORY

Using the themes of leadership and beliefs, our pupils will be finding out about how key Greek ideas and individuals have changed the course of History. Examples such as democracy and the Olympic Games will be studied in depth.

Science

In this topic, the pupils will be learning about different sources of light and how shadows are formed. This knowledge will then be used to investigate how shadow shapes and length can be affected by the distance between the light source and object.

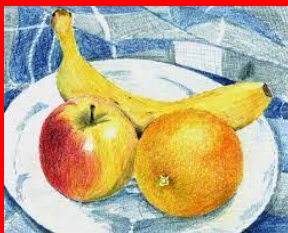
RE

Following on from our work at Christmas, we will be studying the figure of Jesus in more detail and the ideals and messages that he spread. By looking at significant moments in his life, we will find out about why he is so important to Christians around the world.

PE

In Dance, we will be reacting to a stimulus to move in unison with our partner, as well as changing the actions and dynamics of our routine to tell a story.

In football, we will be focusing on our attacking and defending skills, as well as the role of tactics in maintaining possession.



ART AND COMPUTING

Children will explore artists working with the genre of still life, contemporary and more traditional. They will create their own still life inspired art work. In Computing, we will be looking at how we can sequence music using different programmes.



FRENCH AND MUSIC

The children will be learning the names for a variety of animals in French and will be able to explain which ones they like or dislike. In Music, we will be studying the genre of Reggae, looking at some of the music of Jimi Hendrix.
