HISTORY

This half term, we will be studying our local area and observing how Spennymoor has changed over time. We will be comparing old and new photographs and maps, as well as speaking to members of our family about what has changed.

Science

In Science we will be looking at plants and the key things that they need to grow. We will explore lots of different types of plants in order to name each part and identify the locations that they can be found in.

RE

In our RE lessons, we will be looking at the Northern Saints, and learning about the life of St Cuthbert. We will recall his journey and the links that our region has to his story, such as in Durham Cathedral and the work of St Cuthbert's hospice.

PE

In fitness, pupils will develop their understanding of the benefits of exercise and a healthy lifestyle on their physical body, their mood and their overall health. They will work to complete challenges in which they will sometimes need to persevere to achieve their personal best.



ART AND COMPUTING

Children will explore the work of architects and some of the ways they work in their Art sessions, and then create their own architectural models. In Computing, we will be looking at how we can use technology can be used to collect and record different types of data.



PSHE

Year 1 will be thinking about money, where it comes from and the importance of how we use it. Year 2 will be developing their world view by comparing their own lives to those of others from different cultures and traditions.
