GEOGRAPHY

This half term, we will be considering some of the environmental issues affecting both our local area and the wider world, such as pollution and increasing populations. We will be completing field work within Spennymoor to investigate these issues.

Science

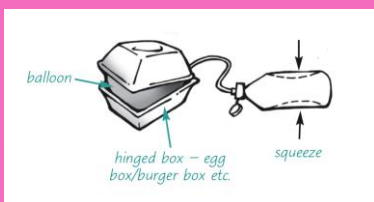
The students will be investigating the suitability of different materials for a range of different purposes. One area considered will be that of absorbency, experimenting to find which materials can absorb the most liquid.

RE

In RE, we will be considering the significance of Durham Cathedral to the Christian faith and discussing why pilgrims have long considered this a sacred place within our locality. We will also begin to make comparisons with other religious buildings.

PE

In Outdoor Adventurous Activities (OAA), children will be using the wider school grounds to complete a range of team building exercises. In Athletics, pupils will develop their track and field skills in preparation for Sports Day.



DT AND FRENCH

In DT, children will investigate products that use air to make them work. In French, we will be studying the topic of 'picnics', recalling key vocabulary linked to the food items that we might take with us on our very own picnic!



RSE

Year 3 will be considering how we can be respectful of differences linked to the British Values. Year 4 will recognise that all people have human rights and how they can make choices to respect other people's rights.
