GEOGRAPHY

This half term, we will be studying the continent of North America, identifying its key human and physical features, and using these to make detailed comparisons between regions within and beyond the continent.

Science

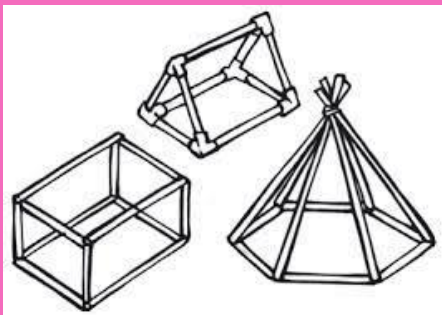
Year 5 will be recapping their previous work on materials and further investigating reversible and irreversible changes. Year 6 are studying light, how it travels, and how shadows are created. We will also explore how light can be 'bent' or reflected.

RE

In RE, we will be developing our understanding of rituals vs. routines across a range of religions, and how these are used in daily life. Year 6 will also be summarizing their work on Christianity, ready for Year 7.

PE

In Outdoor Adventurous Activities (OAA), children will be working with visitors to school to complete team building and orienteering exercises. In Athletics, pupils will develop their track and field skills in preparation for Sports Day.



DT AND MUSIC

In DT, we will learn how to join paper straws together in different ways to make frame structures and use this knowledge to design and make our own frame structure. In Music, we will be compositions our own short pieces using a range of symbols and sounds.



RSE

Year 5 will think about how money is used in the wider world. It will explore financial risks and how to avoid these. Year 6 will explore the ideas of sustainability and the harmful effects of global warming.
